The second SEFFF Loch-style qualifier gave us more of the excellent top of the water fishing Bewl has been enjoying recently, apparently regardless of the degree of cloud cover. Today began with good overcast conditions which broke up around mid-day to give us a brighter afternoon, plus a wind which rarely deviated from the N/NNE direction it had been in for most of the week. Although a lot of the field concentrated on a washing-line approach, either on Intermediate or Floater, Simon Newman had a remarkable spell of action on dries, with about thirty chances in the morning, even if he was only able to convert a fraction of those. Simon, like many others, chose to drift out from the Dam to Chingley, finding fish right across the Main Basin, with a concentration close to the Chingley bank up to the point. One exception to this was Paul Canning and Peter Young, who headed for the Cages and ended up among the earliest finishers, even if their fish were not the heaviest. With over two thirds of the field getting their limit, bag weight was often a deciding factor in the eventual position. Mick Priest had both a good bag, including a couple of 3lbs+ fish, and finished early, promoting him to overall 2nd place, behind the ever-consistent Joel Beenev, winning this event for the second year running. The other probable qualifiers are: Mike Heritage, Ray French, Andrew Green and Bill Rankin.
