The 2011 International Team Bank Championship will be organized by the Confederation of English Fly Fishers and will be fished to the CEFF English Open Small Water Stillwater Championship Rules with the exception of the CEFF Competition rules on eligibility. The competition will consist of a number of Regional Heats throughout the UK cumulating in the International Team Final held at Westlow Mere Fishery, Cheshire. Teams may enter as many Regional Heats as they like, although we cannot guarantee the Team a place (there is a limit of approximately 75 places) and reserve the right to move the Team to an alternative venue. Entries will be dealt with on a first come first served basis.

Entry to the Team Competition costs £10 per Team member and ia Greys Fly Line may be purchased at a discounted rate. You may enter other heats for the same Entry fee. Entry fees are used to cover Management costs and prizes. They are not refundable in any circumstances. Competitors will also be charged fishing fees for the heats and Grand finals. These will be payable on the day unless previously specified.

The number of qualifiers to the Grand Finals from each Regional heat will be calculated on a pro-rata to the overall entry numbers. At least 1 Team will qualify from each heat.

If a Team qualifies more than once, due to multiple entries at the Regional heats, then their Grand Final place will be allocated to the reserve places at the relevant heats on completion of the heat.

General Competition Rules.

Fishing in any CEFF competition will be carried out in the spirit of, and with respect for, the traditions of the sport.

Where required in England, all competitors must be in possession of a valid Environmental Agency rod licence.

Accidentally foul hooked fish will be allowed throughout the Competition. Sight bobs must be capable of catching fish, I.E. they must include a barbless/de-barbed hook.

Wading will be at the discretion of the Heat organizer, However, All forms of waders that cover the hips (waist or chest waders) will be expressly banned at the Individual and Team Grand finals as will waterproof trousers covering Wellies or Waders.

Mobile telephones may be taken onto the fisheries, must be turned off and may only be used for emergency purposes. Mobile telephones or any other electronic communication device may not be used to communicate with other competitors under any circumstances, either by voice message or text message. Anglers found to be breaking this rule will be disqualified from the Competition. Fish finding devices are also banned from use during the day of the competition

A maximum of three rods, none exceeding 12' feet in length, may be carried in Heats and the Grand Finals, though only one at a time may be used. Competitors are responsible for providing their own knotless mesh landing nets. Irrespective of fishery rules, competitors are not permitted to use shooting heads or joined or lead-core lines.

Any dispute or complaint must be reported to a match official within 30 minutes of the end of the match. For a Regional Heat the Match Organiser will adjudicate within one hour. For the Grand Final the National Organisers will adjudicate within one hour. If the adjudicator(s) considers that a competitor has not complied with the rules, it may disqualify. A competitor may appeal against a decision to the CEFF, (or Organising Body as appropriate) in writing, within 7 days of being informed of any penalty. Any review must be concluded within 28 days.

Competitors are not permitted to engage in any form of betting, including sweepstakes, connected with their competitions.
